Subject: HIT AND RUN CRASH CAUGHT ON CAMERA

On March 31, 2020, at approximately 5:30 p.m., City of Miami Police officers responded to a hit and run crash involving a pedestrian in the area of N.W. 14th Avenue and 42nd Street.

Once police officers arrived, preliminary investigation revealed that the pedestrian, a 12-year-old boy was playing on the street when a 2000 black Ford F-150 pick-up truck traveling westbound on N.W. 42nd Street struck the young victim and fled the scene.

The victim was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital via Miami Fire Rescue. He remains in critical condition.
