MPD PAL YOUTH CENTER **BURGLARIZED**

Miami Police Detectives are investigating a commercial burglary that occurred on Thursday, August 4, 2022.

At approximately 12:30 p.m. on August 4, 2022, officers were dispatched to the Miami Police Department's Police Athletic League Center located at 7200 N.E. 2 Avenue inside of the New Haven Housing Development to investigate a reported burglary at the location. Officers met with the complainant who reported that upon arriving at the incident location, he discovered the building's back doors pried open with damaged locks.

According to the preliminary investigation, it appears that unknown suspect(s) burglarized the youth center, ransacked, and stole several items to include televisions, computers, a printer, PlayStation games and controllers from the location.

Detectives are actively investigating this case and need assistance in identifying those who are responsible.

The Miami Police Department will not be dissuaded from their dedicative duty in continuing to work closely with the youth within our community to build trust and a better path moving forward.
