RESIDENCE BURGLARIZED

Miami Police Detectives are investigating a burglary that occurred on Saturday, May 13, 2023.

At approximately 4:50 a.m. on May 13, 2022, officers were dispatched to a home located at the 1100 Block of N.W. 46 Street to investigate a residential burglary at the location. Officers met with the complainant who reported that upon arriving at the incident location, he observed a damaged rear window and door.

According to the preliminary investigation and surveillance footage, it appears that an unknown suspect unlawfully walked onto the victim's gated property and burglarized the victim's place of residence and stole several items to include electronics and tools.

Detectives are actively investigating this case and need assistance in identifying the suspect responsible.
