## OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

Today, Thursday, December 31, 2020, at approximately 8:20 a.m., Miami Police officers responded to 911 calls of shots heard fired in the area of S.W. 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue and S.W. 28<sup>th</sup> Street.

According to investigators, the responding officers were also flagged down by nearby residents who stated they heard shots fired within the area. Officers immediately began investigating the circumstances surrounding the incident. While on scene, a male subject confronted our officers. One of our officers was forced to discharge his weapon, striking the subject. The officers began to render aid until Miami Fire Rescue personnel arrived.

Miami Fire Rescue responded and transported the subject to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center in critical condition.

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement along with our Internal Affairs Section will be leading the investigation.
