Subject: DEATH INVESTIGATION

On Sunday, December 15, 2019, shortly after 9 p.m. Miami Police officers responded to the rear area of 3000 S.W. 28 Lane in reference to a 911 call of an unresponsive male.

According to investigators, the victim was discovered on a grassy area behind a business and near the walking path under the Miami-Dade Metrorail. The victim was unresponsive and appeared to be injured.

City of Miami Fire Rescue personnel responded to the scene and pronounced the victim deceased on the scene.

Detectives are investigating the possible motive(s) and ask that anyone with information on this incident to please contact the Miami Police Department or Crimestoppers.
