Subject: WOMAN SEVERELY BATTERED

On Thursday, December 31, 2020, at approximately 5:45 p.m., Miami Police responded to 1633 North Bayshore Drive to investigate a call of a woman found unresponsive inside a hotel room.

According to detectives, once officers arrived on scene, they made contact with a hotel representative who reported that the guest failed to checkout of the hotel room on the scheduled date which led to a room inspection. Upon inspection, a woman was found unresponsive and severely battered.

The woman was immediately taken to Jackson Memorial Hospital by Miami Fire Rescue where she received extensive treatment.

Detectives have been actively investigating this case and have since exhausted all leads and are requesting the community's assistance.

Person of Interest #1: white male, black hair mohawk style. Last seen wearing a black mask, red shirt, jean jacket with camouflage pants and sneakers.

Person of Interest #2: black male. Last seen wearing a light-colored hat, white mask, black shirt and black long pants.
