SHOOTING INVESTIGATION

On Tuesday, January 5, 2021, at approximately 8:00 p.m., City of Miami Police responded to the area of N.W. 2nd Avenue and 56th Street in reference to a shot spotter alert.

According to detectives, two victims, a male and female were inside a 2007 Mazda while a third male victim was walking along N.W. 56th Street when unknown armed suspect(s) began shooting at them. Immediately after, an orange Dodge Charger can be seen fleeing the scene on nearby surveillance footage. Both male victims were immediately transported via Miami Fire Rescue to Jackson Memorial Ryder Trauma Center.

The motive behind the shooting remains under investigation.
