Subject: MIAMI POLICE SATURATION PATROL



The Miami Police Department will be conducting a Saturation Patrol tomorrow, **Saturday, July 10, 2021**. It will take place in the City of Miami's South District Coral Way, Flagami and Little Havana NET service areas. The operation will be conducted during the hours of **5 p.m. to 3 a.m.**

The goal of this Saturation Patrol is to provide a continuing effort to reduce traffic related injuries and fatalities on our roadways. The operation will consist of traffic enforcement officers deploying to different locations throughout the South District which have been identified through the collection of traffic crash data, and traffic complaints in recent months. Traffic enforcement officers will concentrate their efforts at the predetermined locations and show zero tolerance for violations of Driving While License Suspended, Non-Valid Drivers License, No Insurance, No Seatbelt, Speeding and Driving Under the Influence.

This effort is in conjunction with the "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over", "Lets Eliminate Aggressive Driving" and the "Buckle Up Florida: Click It or Ticket" campaigns.
