Miami Police Gang Unit Executes Warrant For Violent Gang

From October 28, 2025, to November 3, 2025, the Miami Gang Unit observed several associates of the violent gang ABK (Any Body Killer) frequenting a residence at 10010 SW 162nd Street, arriving in luxury vehicles valued at over \$100,000. Key individuals identified included Holcombe, Johnson, and Cherenfant, all of whom have ties to the gang's history of violent and white-collar crimes, such as identity theft.

On November 4, 2025, a search warrant was issued for the location as part of an investigation into gang-related firearms. The following day, the Miami Gang Unit, alongside the Miami-Dade Sheriff's Office (MDSO) Special Response Team (SRT), the MDSO South Gangs Unit, and the FBI Violent Gang Task Force, executed the warrant.

During the operation, MDSO SRT apprehended four suspects who attempted to escape from the rear of the house, while seven others were detained inside. Authorities recovered five firearms, including Glock and FN models, and seized over \$8,100 in cash, with specific amounts traced to co-conspirators Cherenfant and Holcombe. Evidence of organized fraud was uncovered, including multiple laptops, phones, and debit and credit cards belonging to victims who were not present during the raid.

The investigation revealed that the residence had been transformed into a fraudulent call center, using background sounds to mislead victims into disclosing personal information. A total of 11 individuals were arrested in connection with the operation.

The City of Miami Police Gang Unit remains committed to combating criminal activities by gangs and criminal enterprises attempting to operate in our community.
