Subject: GIRL IN LATE TEENS SHOT OUTSIDE PARK



Today, at approximately 4:00 PM, The City of Miami Police Department responded to the Curtis Park Pool Section located at 2300 Northwest North River Drive, after receiving a 911 call of a young girl shot outside the park area.

According to the on-scene investigation, the victim was standing in the parking lot area of the pool section at Curtis Park when an unknown person armed with a gun began shooting at her, striking her in the leg. The gunman fled the scene in an unknown direction.

The victim, Meagan Hernandez, D.O.B. 7-9-96 was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Unit via Miami Fire Rescue in stable condition.

The motive is unknown and the investigation continues....
