Downtown/Brickell - 6:00 AM - 2:00 PM  
MacArthur Cswy EB - 5:00 AM - 8:00 AM  
Miami Beach Area - 5:00 AM - 10:00 AM  
Venetian Cswy - 6:00 AM - 10:00 AM  
Coconut Grove Area - 6:30 AM - 12:45 AM  
Rickenbacker Cswy - 6:30 AM - 1:00 PM

We recommend that all those wanting to enter or exit Miami Beach between 6:00 AM and 10:00 AM use the Julia Tuttle Causeway. Additionally, Those downtown residents east of Miami Ave. can access or exit the area by taking 5th Street towards the port of Miami and using the port tunnel to access 836 and I-95. Roads will be closed and Managed by City of Miami, Miami Beach, and Miami Dade County Police Departments, who will assist traffic through intersections between gaps of runners.
