Subject: **HIT-AND-RUN – NEED TO IDENTIFY**

Traffic Homicide detectives have exhausted all investigative means and are asking for the public's help identifying a suspect involved in a hit and run crash that left a man critically injured.

On July 23, 2022, at approximately 1:30 a.m. Miami Police officers responded to a call of a pedestrian that was hit by a vehicle at N.W. 20 Avenue and 36 Street. Upon arriving the officers located the victim who was hit by an SUV. After hitting the victim, the SUV continued without making any attempt to stop.

Surveillance video shows the victim crossing N.W. 36 Street from south to north and the SUV traveling westbound on N.W. 36 Street.

The victim was seriously injured and was taken to JMH Trauma where he underwent emergency surgery. The victim is still slowly recovering from his numerous injuries.

Suspect: UNKNOWN

Vehicle: White, Chevrolet Suburban that possibly had notable front passenger side damage and a broken headlight.
