FAMILY PLEA – HOMICIDE OF TORRELL DEWEY PHILLIPS

On Sunday, September 25, 2022, at approximately 12:06 a.m. officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert of several rounds fired at 1119 NW 3 Avenue.

Upon arriving officers located an unresponsive male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The victim, who was later identified as **Torrell Dewey Phillips 12/19/1984**, was transported to JMH Trauma where he was pronounced deceased.

Homicide Detectives were able to obtain surveillance video showing the victim exiting “Shop for Less” Convenience Store. The victim then mounts his bicycle and begins to pedal away when two unknown black males ran towards the victim and began to fire upon him. The two suspects then ran away from the crime.

Detectives have exhausted all leads and need your help in identifying the suspects.

A family plea will take place **Today, Friday, June 7, 2024, at 1:00 p.m.** in the Miami Police Department’s Public Information Office located at 400 N.W. 2 Avenue. The victim’s family will be present to speak with media.
