Subject: Crime Unfolds In Surveillance Video



On Sunday, May 30th, 2010 at approximately 2:30 P.M., three men had just walked out of their place of business located at 7553 N. Miami Avenue shortly before getting into their family car, when they were robbed at gunpoint by two black males described as follows:

1st Suspect: Black male, armed with a handgun, 25-28 years old, approximately 5'10" tall, 170lbs, last seen wearing a brown T-shirt and black pants.

2nd Suspect: Black male, 25-28 years old, approximately 5'9" tall, 140lbs, last seen wearing a black T-shirt and dark pants.

According to the on-scene investigation, two black males, one of them armed with a handgun, walked up to the victims, demand money, personal belongings and keys at gunpoint. Immediately and without hesitation, all three victims complied. The two suspects then jumped into Victim #1's parked car, a 2008 Infiniti F35 Sports Utility Vehicle adjacent to them, and sped off in the northbound direction. Minutes later, the SUV was located, abandoned by the thieves at North Bayshore Drive and Northeast 61st Street.
