Subject: **THREATS TO PUBLIC OFFICIALS INVESTIGATION**

City of Miami Mayor, Francis Suarez, and other officials received threats by a subject later identified as Ricardo Hernandez.

After an extensive investigation, it was determined that Mr. Hernandez was responsible for alarming threats made to City of Hialeah Mayor Carlos Hernandez and Senator Marco Rubio.

The Miami Police Department provided the information to the City of Hialeah Police Department who worked tirelessly in locating the subject. A tip from a concerned citizen was received and the subject was located at his home at 1339 W. 49 Place #414 in Hialeah, FL. Mr. Hernandez has since been transported to a crisis health facility for evaluation and/or treatment.

The Miami Police Department along with our neighboring agencies will always take every step possible to ensure the safety of the community we serve.
