Subject: Walk A Mile With A Child



The “Walk a Mile with a Child” walk will take place on Saturday, April 16, 2016. This walk will impact the normal traffic flow of the Overtown/Downtown NET area along with the ingress and egress to many residences and businesses in the area. Listed below is the turn by turn route that will be used for this walk. Please take note these streets will be affected by this walk until approximately 11:30 A.M.

- The walk will start at 8:30 AM in front of Gibson Park.
- 500 walkers expected to participate.
- Streets closures will commence at 8:15 A.M.
- The streets shall reopen by 12:00 P.M.

RACE COURSE

The walk will start at Gibson Park, proceed North on NW 3 Avenue to NW 14 Street, then right (East) on NW 14 Street. They will then turn right (South) on NW 2 Avenue. The walkers will turn left on NW 11 Street to NW 2 Avenue, where they will make a right (South). The walkers will continue South on NW 2 Avenue to NW 8 St., where they will make a right (West) towards NW 3 Avenue. They will turn right (North) onto NW 3 Avenue to NW 12 Street where the walk will end.

Miami Police Officers will be deployed along the route to assist motorists.
